So... why am I telling you this? So you don't miss any of our newest content!

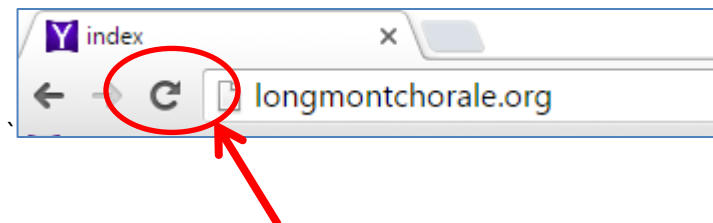
Here's how:

For Internet Explorer browser:



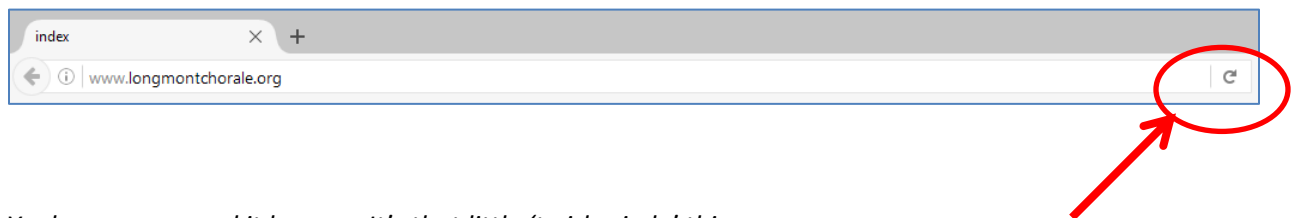
the magic 'refresh' button
